SENIOR TECHNICIAN – GENERATORS

Job Purpose

The incumbent is responsible for repairing and ensuring the efficient functioning of Cummins equipment. This position reports directly to the CPG and EBU Team Leader.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

- Performs field installation, repairs and maintenance of equipment
- Services, repairs and diagnoses diesel engines and fuel systems according to manufacturer's specifications.
- Services, troubleshoots and repairs generators and switchgears in residential, marine, commercial, industrial and offshore applications.
- Coaches and mentors Technicians.
- Performs preventative maintenance checks on generators and switchgears based on client contract.
- Performs the commissioning, reconfiguration and programming of generators and switchgears.
- Conducts controller upgrades on generators within both the Commercial and Oil and Gas industries.
- Carries out computer diagnostics, calibrations and repairs on generators and engines.
- Prepares estimates and technical reports.
- Completes training schedule and ensures that the required certification is achieved within the specified timeframe.
- Assists in conducting research for repair parts and procedures concerning jobs.
- Maintains updated knowledge of product and industry trends and methods.
- Maintains accurate records related to billing, work orders and hours worked.
- Ensures the effective and timely completion of projects.
- Responds to Call-out duty 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.
- Maintains awareness of and continually practices safe work habits.
- Maintains cleanliness on projects both during and after job completion.
- Any other related responsibilities assigned by Management.
